

## Hybrid Mittens in the Round



Shown are the Hybrid Mittens (not in the round)

### Pattern

This is a modification of the regular Hybrid Mittens pattern. These are simple mittens knitted in the round to prevent seaming.

Use worsted or aran wt. yarn and a size 8 needle (or whatever to get gauge). I used Peruvia Colors by Berroco.

Gauge:

CO 28 st. Place marker to show beginning.

Join in the round and work desired cuff length (I did 1 ½ in) in 1x1 ribbing (k1,p1)

### Work mitten body:

1. K
2. K
3. K11, Knit in front of stitch and in back of stitch (KFB), K4, KFB, K11 (30st)
4. K
5. K12, KFB, K4, KFB, K12 (32st)
6. K
7. K
8. K
9. K13, KFB, K4, KFB, K13 (34st)
10. K
11. K14, KFB, K4, KFB, K14 (36st)
12. K
13. K
14. K
15. K
16. Knit 21, place 6 st on holder (the ones that were just knitted), knit the rest of row
17. K15, CO2, K15 (32st)

Continue in Stockinette st until stockinette section measures 4in.

### Work Opening:

1. K1, BO 14 st us, K 17 (remaining 16 st)
2. K 1, CO 14, Knit to end of row
3. K (all 32 st)

Continue to work in Stockinette st until desired length minus ½ in.

### **Decrease for Shaping:**

1. K2tog,K12,K2tog,K2tog,K12,K2tog (28st)
2. K
3. K2tog,K10,K2tog,K2tog,K10,K2tog (24st)
4. K
5. K2tog,K8,K2tog,K2tog,K8,K2tog (20 st)
6. K
7. K2tog,K6,K2tog,K2tog,K6, K2tog (16 st)
8. K2tog,K4,K2tog,K2tog,K4,K2tog

Use Kitchener stitch to graft together the tops.

### **Finish Opening:**

1. Pick up 16 of the bottom st.
2. Work in 1x ribbing for 16 st.

Work in pattern for ½ in, BO in pattern

Work top portion in the same manner.

This will create an opening that will have a slight overlap.

### **Thumb:**

1. from inside center of thumb, PU 3, K6,PU3
2. P
3. K

Work in Stockinette St for 2 in

Decrease for Thumb

1. K2tog,K2tog,K to last 4 st, K2tog,K2tog

2. P
3. K2tog x4

Break yarn with ample enough to draw through the remaining st, sew down side of thumb, and weave in ends

**Please remember to knit the second mitten for the opposite hand. All you will need to do is follow the pattern except use this for the second hand. Everything else stays the same.**

### **Work Opening (second hand)**

Knit 17, BO 14, Knit 1

Knit17, CO 14, Knit 1.

Now you have the opening for the fingers.

Continue to work in Stockinette st until desired length minus 1 in.
